

## Health Insurance Coverage of the Nonelderly Population, 2008




Medicaid/Other Public includes: Medicaid, CHIP, other state programs, Medicare, and military-related coverage.

(Millions of Americans)



# Health Insurance Coverage by Poverty Level, 2008




#### Characteristics of the Uninsured, 2008

# Nonelderly Uninsured by Poverty Levels and Age, 2008


