



# Number of Uninsured by Amount of Time Uninsured





## Uninsured Non-elderly Adult Population by Age, 2003





#### Problems Obtaining Needed Care Among Non-elderly Adults, Uninsured vs. Insured, 2000






# Non-elderly Adults Uninsured by Poverty Status, 2003


Uninsured Workers by Eligibility for Employer Sponsored Health Insurance, 2001






