# Timeline for Enactment

## Phase I

Passed House: 3/14  
Passed Senate: 3/18  
Signed: 3/18

## Phase III

Passed House: 3/4  
Passed Senate: 3/5  
Signed: 3/6

## Phase II

Passed Senate: 3/26  
Passed House: 3/27  
Signed: 3/27 (later today)



# Additional Coronavirus Bills

- Phase IV and Phase V of COVID-19 response legislation will likely unfold in the coming weeks and months.
- The package could include additional supplemental funding for agencies, technical corrections to Phase III, and policies to deal with existing and emerging issues pertaining to the outbreak.
- Remote voting plans aren't likely, but Congress could change rules pertaining to "proxy" voting for emergencies only.
