- Fewer Coverage Options (some only HMOs)
- Unstable Premiums
- Commissions Being Eliminated
- Lower Uninsured Rate
- Access for Vulnerable Populations

The Underlying Problems

- There Are Systemic Issues that Must Be Addressed
 - Unsustainable Cost Growth (cost and utilization)
 - Unstable Risk Pool
 - Unreliable Funding
 - Uncertain Regulatory Environment
